Grade Equivalency Scores of Visitation Catholic School Students

Grade Equivalency Scores indicate the level of work that our students can complete. The students take the Iowa Assessments in April. Since April is the eighth month of the school year, a 4th grade student taking the test would be at a grade level of 4.8. If this 4th grade student received a Grade Level Equivalency of 6.6 in reading, that indicates how a 6th grade student in the sixth month of school would be expected to score on that 4th grade test. As a note, it does not mean that this particular 4th grade student can do work from the sixth month of sixth grade. The highest grade level that can be achieved is 13+. This was the first year we have had 3rd grade take this assessment. For the Class of 2018-2021, we have student scores for this year and last for comparison reasons.

A.C.R.E. Assessment

In addition to the Iowa Assessments standardized test, we administer the Assessment of Catechesis/Religious Education (A.C.R.E.). This test is designed to strengthen the religion instruction that we provide for our students by assisting us in evaluating their faith knowledge and attitudes.

As an integrated assessment tool, the A.C.R.E. provides faith knowledge questions (cognitive domain) and questions related to religious beliefs, attitudes, practices and perceptions (affective domain). The test is designed for students in grades five and eight. The students are asked to answer questions in the following areas:

- God: Father, Son & Holy Spirit
- Liturgy & Sacraments
- Life in Christ: Morality & Catholic Social Teaching
- Prayer/Religious Practices
- Church: One, Holy Catholic & Apostolic
- Revelation: Scripture & Faith
- Church History
- Catholic Faith Literacy

A summary of our results compared to the national parish average for the 2017-2018 school year on the A.C.R.E. test cognitive domain are below:
