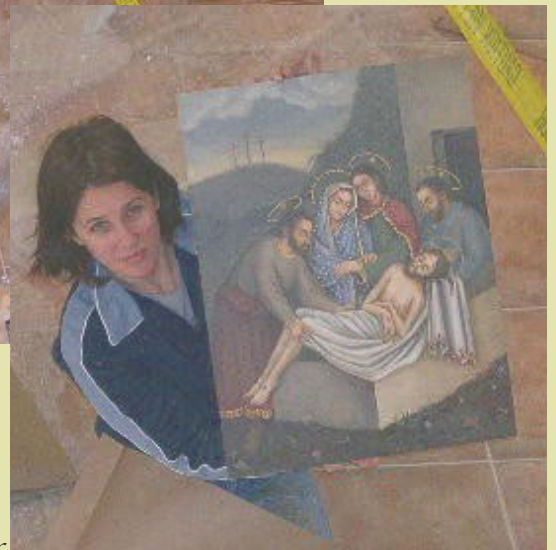


VISITATION PARISH

PASTOR'S CORNER



Dear Parishioners,

Though it's the middle of the summer, things are buzzing on our campus! When I walk over to school, there's a great energy happening in the office and throughout the building! With Dr. Wagner's arrival as principal, and with our great teachers and staff, there's a building energy for the school year ahead. Things are being delivered and moved around, rooms are being painted, people are meeting and planning and there's a palpable excitement in the building!

The parish office is busy as well. We are painting and rearranging, meeting and planning, and getting a lot of great things lined up for the year ahead. Next weekend at Mass, we begin hearing from a section of John's Gospel called the Bread of Life discourses. Though this Lectionary year features the Gospel of Mark most Sundays, we have an interlude of readings from John's Gospel because Mark's Gospel is so short. In these Gospel passages, Jesus feeds a large crowd, refers to himself as the Bread of Life and talks of the gift of his flesh and blood, while the crowds wrestle with the mystery of his miracles and his words. So we have the opportunity to reflect on the gift of the Eucharist as our source and summit, as communion with God and one another, as the sacrifice that nourishes us in living the Paschal Mystery into which we've been baptized. The parish staff and I have created some YouTube videos from parishioners reflecting on the gift of the Eucharist in their lives, and will also have outdoor banners that celebrate various dimensions of Eucharist. It's a special gift the lectionary gives us this summer. I hope you will be blessed by the scriptures, the liturgies, the videos, the banners and the real presence of Christ alive in this community!

ON AUGUST 3, HEAD TO THE PASEO BOULEVARD BETWEEN 18TH AND TRUMAN ROAD, FOR THE HEART OF AMERICA HOT DOG FESTIVAL!

The Negro Leagues Baseball Museum (NLBM) is set to get things “Grillin’ and Groovin’” again at Historic 18th & Vine when it plays host to the 2024 Heart of America Hot Dog Festival, presented by Hy-Vee. “We’re thrilled to bring the Hot Dog Festival back to Historic 18th & Vine,” said Bob Kendrick, NLBM President. “While ballpark foods have become more sophisticated over recent years, baseball fans still relish the hot dog. The Heart of America Hot Dog Festival unites fans around that common bond in a fun and entertaining celebration. It has been tremendously gratifying to see this event grow to become one of the most highly anticipated outdoor music festivals in Kansas City,” Kendrick said.

The festival will be held from 3:00 -11:00 pm on Saturday, August 3. The event features live entertainment, food and more. Established by the NLBM in partnership with Hy-Vee in 2013, the Heart of America Hot Dog Festival celebrates the historical connection between our national pastime and the all-American hot dog has become one of the most highly anticipated festivals in the region.
