PASTOR'S CORNER

Dear Parishioners.

Respect Life month brings both a comforting and challenging message. I love our conviction that every life is sacred. There's so much hope in that belief, as it underlines God's abiding presence with each human being, from the moment of conception to natural death and throughout every decade. The challenges of life can pile up, but remembering the sacredness of my life, your life, every life testifies to God's intimate presence to each of us.

But the challenge is also there. The sacredness of life demands sacred treatment of the unborn, the dying, the one condemned to die, the frustrating neighbor, the annoying

driver, the perpetrators of our hurts and wounds. Recognizing the sacred character in every human being is always going to challenge us. Treating another person with the life-giving goodness of God, especially when we don't feel like it, is tough. But it underlines Jesus' call to be like our Heavenly Father.
