



PASTOR'S CORNER

Dear Parishioners,

Bishop Johnston recently shared a letter reiterating our church's teaching on the dignity of the human person. At one point, he states:

"The United States Conference of Catholic Bishops has consistently emphasized the Church's unwavering dedication to upholding the dignity of every human person, regardless of their immigration status. Archbishop Timothy P. Broglio, president of the USCCB, reminds us that our actions as a nation should "demonstrate a genuine care for our most vulnerable sisters and brothers, including the unborn, the poor, the elderly and infirm, and migrants and refugees."



This consistent ethic of life makes a claim on us to stand in solidarity with any human being whose life and dignity is threatened. The bishop encourages us in his letter to pray, educate ourselves, extend a hand of welcome and advocate for justice. We are in conversation with other deanery parishes to find concrete ways to put this teaching into practice, so as to stand in solidarity with migrants, immigrants and refugees in these uncertain days.

The bishop has also asked us this weekend to reflect on the call to priesthood and religious life through the Called By Name program. I feel fortunate to be a priest, and to be with you here at Visitation. It's been an eventful and fulfilling life for me! If you know of someone you'd encourage to think about the priesthood or religious life, mention it to them and offer them your prayers.


