RACIAL JUSTICE



The Racial Justice Committee is in the midst of again offering the Just Faith program, Faith and Racial Healing. This eight-week series invites participants to form their own Christian rooted responses to racism. Offering articles, videos and resource books (*The Color of Compromise and Post Traumatic Slave Syndrome*) while fostering active listening, prayer and dialogue, the series lends new insights and deepens awareness of racism and privilege.

This is the ninth time RJC has offered this series—to parishioners and in recent sessions, some non-parishioners as well. This time a group of 18 has committed to this process, representing Visitation, St. Francis Xavier, St. Monica and two members of the diocesan leadership team. It is a wonderful group of open and committed folks—and we are so very grateful for the gift of their time as they join over 100 people who are Vis Just Faith alumni.

Most recently the group watched and discussed Stephen Spielberg's *Middle Passage*. https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=yvhKeJ6m3rY.

At the conclusion of the session, participants were invited to write two prayers—a prayer for those who were enslaved and a personal prayer. Here are a few of the prayers written that evening.

Personal prayer for those who were enslaved:

May you live in eternal peace, grace, beauty, light and freedom

O Holy one, as I learn ever more deeply the true history of how the formerly enslaved suffered and listen to their voices, I celebrate these Saints in heaven now reunited with you. I pray for their everlasting heavenly joy as they rest in Your loving arms.

May you rest in glory where you know God's abundant love that eases all pain and wipes away all tears. From God's communion of saints, may you continue to intercede on behalf of broken humanity nudging those who cling to blindness, fear and ignorance, instilling courage and determination and swell the numbers for all who pursue justice.

Prayer for myself:

God, please grant that I may open my eyes to current perpetuations of oppression to people of color and that I might seek ways to make tangible change.

I pray for forgiveness for what ancestors of my race did to these Beloved Souls, and I pray for Your guidance and help in doing what I can to heal the results of the Atlantic slave trade and the following injustices that continue to the present day.

Help me Lord to see you as you see, to see my own blindness, to speak with kindness but determination in speaking truth and opening all hearts to the stories of our history.

Heavenly Father, forgive us for the sins of racism and the residual effects of this evil in our society today. Guide our restless hearts and worried spirits to your goodness. Inspire in us the courage to be a light to others, a source of hope in shared concerns and care and an unwavering commitment to justice, healing and peace. Amen.


