

CONFIRMATION CHANGES

PLEASE NOTE: The Diocese of Kansas City - St. Joseph is changing the age of reception for the sacrament of Confirmation to students in the 6th grade. We will be adjusting the program to make sure all Vis children older than 6th grade who have not been confirmed will have the opportunity to be confirmed in the next two years. This will affect the following students:



- ⇒ **Incoming 10th graders** You can enroll in Vis Confirmation prep program this year. Please be on the lookout for more information to come this fall.
- ⇒ **Incoming 9th graders** You will enroll in theConfirmation program next year as a sophomore.
- ⇒ **Incoming 7th and 8th graders who attend Vis** You will receive preparation to be Confirmed through Visitation school.
- ⇒ **Incoming 6th graders who attend Vis** You will receive preparation to be Confirmed next year through Visitation school.
- ⇒ Incoming 6th, 7th, and 8th graders who do not attend a Catholic elementary school You can enroll in the Vis Confirmation prep program later this fall. Please be patient and know there will have to be some flexibility as we all adjust and plan for this new Diocesan initiative. RACIAL JUSTICE



Visitation School will again host four Cristo Rey interns for the 2024-2025 academic year. This joint parish-school partnership began four years ago under the leadership of the parish Racial Justice Committee's Matt Gunter and John McGurk and continues with the financial support this year of nearly 40 parish families.

In anticipation of welcoming the four CR interns to the Vis School campus, where they will assist both faculty and students, Nancy Hesse (Visitation School internship program supervisor) and Peg Ekerdt (RJC co-chair) attended a Supervisor Orientation meeting at Cristo Rey on August 8. Shaylee Ham, Cristo Rey Director of Operations - Corporate Work Study Program, presented information on the coming year's program as well as providing the Successful Supervisor Handbook.

Currently, there are 250 students at Cristo Rey with 110 work partners. Freshmen leave the school to work on Mondays, sophomores on Tuesdays, juniors on Wednesdays and seniors on Thursdays. New this year, all students will be in school on Fridays. As the students begin their years, every workplace is invited to create ways in which to make the students welcome. Students have breakfast at Cristo Rey and sack lunches are also provided. With their weekly job placements, the students' earn 50% of their tuition.

Because this is the first job for many of the students, Cristo Rey helps students in a myriad of ways - with such assistance as facilitating interviewing and email skills as well as developing interpersonal skills that will help them interact in the workplace.

As the school year begins, Ms. Hesse will provide updates on our four students and suggest ways in which we can continue to help these students feel a part of the Visitation Community. (Think Vis School swag!)

The Visitation Cristo Rey internship fund receives contributions all through the year. If you have not had a chance to support this program, please consider adding to our fund as we support the current interns and establish a foundation for the coming year.
